The Historical Association of South Africa (HASA) announces the launch of this new award to the best third year student in History at every participating University in South Africa. This award is in recognition of Prof Johan Bergh who was president of HASA for over two decades and is in line with his on-going commitment to promote History at postgraduate level. The winners will receive a year's subscription to *Historia* and their names will be announced in the first issue of *Historia* in the subsequent year.

All departments of History at universities in South Africa offering postgraduate studies in History are eligible to participate. The selection of the winner is an internal decision by the respective department chairs and their colleagues.
